## Setting:

All pupils are allocated to classes in two groups of subjects:

Classes A-D are based on ability in all subjects other than mathematics.

Particular consideration is given to those with ability in Modern Languages.

Class D is split into two groups of equal ability, Dx and Dy.

Mathematics is setted separately according to ability.

\*Pupils in sets A or B may study Latin instead of taking Music and ICT. Extra music lessons will be provided for those taking Latin and who have a particular interest in music or who wish to take GCSE Music the following year. Latin pupils will also receive an ICT briefing and will complete an individual ICT programme during the year.

Each pupil should have an English dictionary, a geometry set and a Casio FX-85GT Plus Scientific calculator. The calculator can be provided by the Maths Department at the start of term and be charged to the School bill at cost price.
