Hobbies

Thank you to everyone who returned their child's hobby form so promptly which enabled registers to be compiled ahead of them commencing on Monday. This helped us enormously as it meant most children were in the right place this week for either their chosen hobby or for supervision. Please note that we will assume children are being collected at 3.30pm if neither a hobby or supervision has been indicated on the form. Therefore, if you do need your child to stay post 3.30pm but didn't tick the supervision option, please let us know in order we can amend registers. Similarly, if there is a day when you need to collect your child before a hobby/supervision or need them to stay for supervision due to not being able to collect them at 3.30pm please let your child's class teacher know at drop-off.

Forest Adventures: children taking part in this hobby should bring their Forest School clothes to school in a named bag to change into ahead of the hobby.
