Nursery

*All items marked with an * must be purchased from the School Shop.*

All school uniform must be well maintained; children wearing scruffy/worn clothing will be asked to have it repaired or replaced.

Michaelmas and Lent Terms

- Navy tracksuit* (*or plain navy, elasticated leg tracksuit bottoms can be worn*)
- White polo shirt
- Art overall* (*only Pelican 2 Nursery*)
- Coat
- Waterproof jacket*
- Waterproof trousers/dungarees
- Drawstring bag*

Summer Term

As above except the following should be worn in place of the tracksuit.

SCHOOL SHOP

The shop is situated next to our Astro pitch and signposted from the main car park. It opens every **Monday** and **Wednesday (2.30pm - 5pm)** during term time. Existing parents do not need to make appointments during these opening times.

The shop will also be open by appointment only during the first two weeks and the last three weeks of the Summer holidays; it will also be open during the Christmas and Easter holidays. All parents (current and new) can make an appointment by phoning the School Office on 01823 285920.

Payment is due at the time of purchase by debit/credit card for new uniform or by cash/cheque for second-hand uniform.

Michaelmas and Lent Terms

- Blazer*
- Navy V-neck sweater*
- Navy sleeveless pullover* (optional)
- White polyester cotton long-sleeved shirt (no velcro top button)
- School tie*
- Navy fleece jacket*
- Navy fleece hat, scarf and gloves* (optional)
- Waterproof jacket*
- Waterproof trousers/dungarees
- Book bag*
- Art overall*

Uniform A

- Hat*
- Tunic*
- Navy knee length socks or tights (plain ribbed only)
- Navy or black shoes (velcro/bar/lace, low-heeled, not patent/suede, no ballet pumps)

Uniform B

- Cap*
- Mid-grey long or short trousers
- Grey socks
- Black shoes (velcro/lace, not suede)

Please note During Michaelmas and Lent terms, the children in Reception only wear their school uniform three days a week, as they wear their PE kit one day and casuals for Forest School the other.

Summer Term

As above, except the following should be worn in place of the tunic/trousers, long-sleeved shirt and tie.

Uniform A

- Summer dress*
- Boater*
- Navy ankle socks
- Blue sun hat* (legionnaire style)

Uniform B

- Mid-grey shorts
- White polo shirt*
- Grey short socks
- Blue sun hat* (legionnaire style)

All items of uniform, sports kit and personal property should be clearly labelled and looped (where appropriate)

Jewellery should not be worn with the exception of one stud ear-ring per ear.

Year 2 children may wear watches.

Hair should be neat and tidy, and should not be dyed. Long hair must be tied back using a navy-blue hair ribbon/band.

All children must keep a pair of Wellington Boots, school fleece, waterproof jacket and trousers in school throughout the year for play-times and Forest School.

All children must come to and go home from school wearing their blazer and hat/cap.

Games and Equipment
